Presenter: So here you can see [refers to slide] the difference in...the different standard of living of the two banks of the Seine. So on the left there is the next city district which belongs to Villenueve-Le-Roi, and on the right you can see Villenueve Triage. So Villenueve Triage has 50% of social housing. So this social impact of the new access and the link between these two communities will...um...is one of the questions that I'm...that I'm planning to treat for my P5*.

Triage's bank's natural landscape is an asset for the city, so I intend to develop this forsaken area to create a new attraction pull for the inhabitants of the other bank of Villenueve-Le-Roi, and to develop economically Triage, to try to reduce the social differences between the two banks.
